AIRCRAFT PICK-UP POLICY

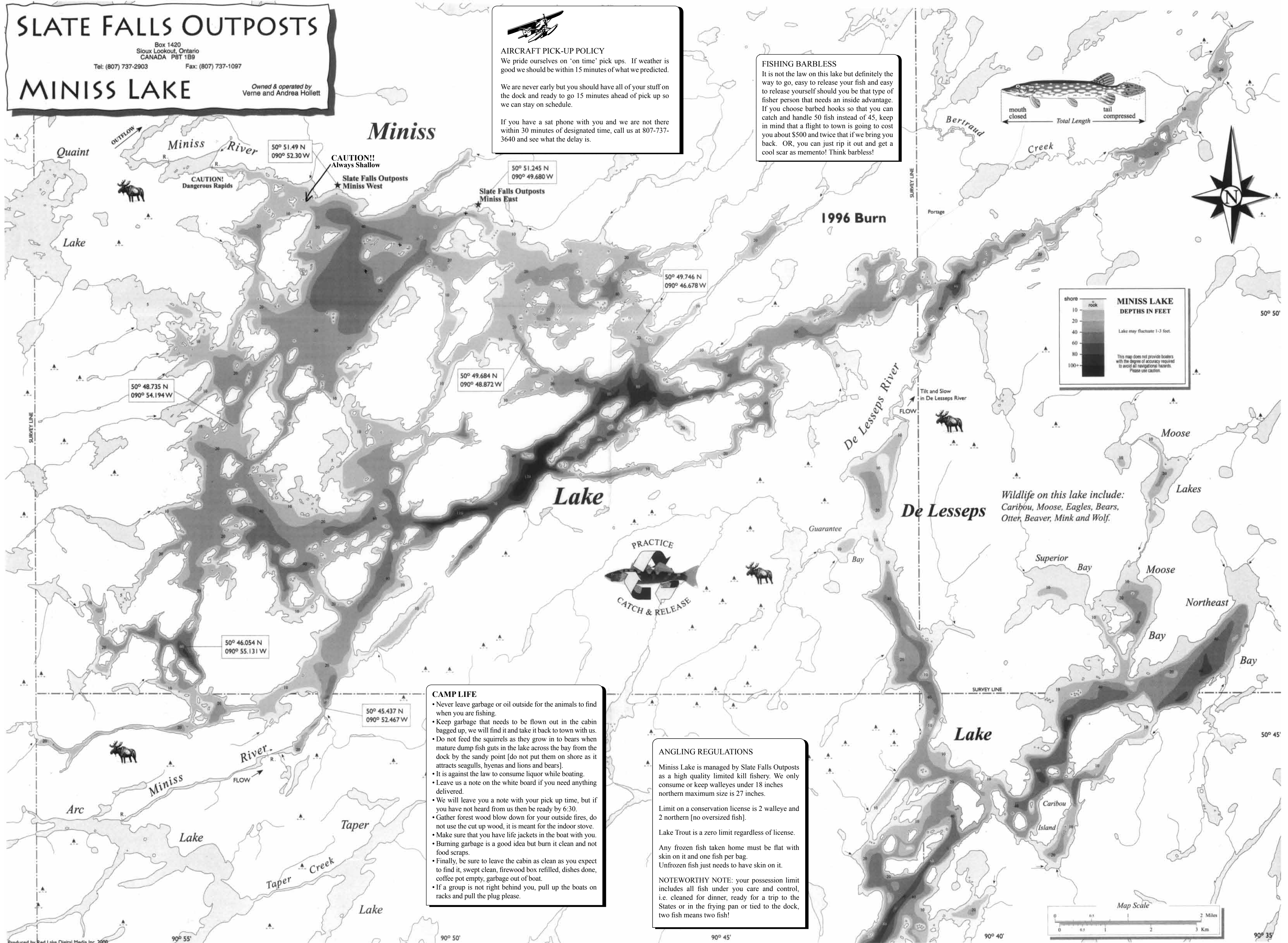
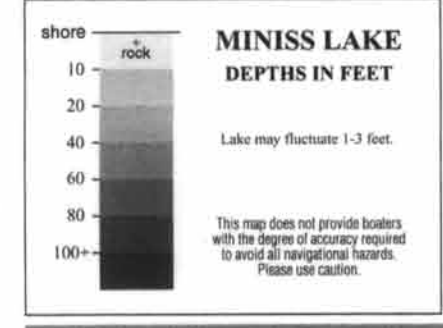
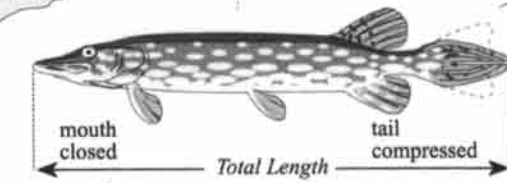
We pride ourselves on 'on time' pick ups. If weather is good we should be within 15 minutes of what we predicted.

We are never early but you should have all of your stuff on the dock and ready to go 15 minutes ahead of pick up so we can stay on schedule.

If you have a sat phone with you and we are not there within 30 minutes of designated time, call us at 807-737-3640 and see what the delay is.

FISHING BARBLESS

It is not the law on this lake but definitely the way to go, easy to release your fish and easy to release yourself should you be that type of fisher person that needs an inside advantage. If you choose barbed hooks so that you can catch and handle 50 fish instead of 45, keep in mind that a flight to town is going to cost you about \$500 and twice that if we bring you back. OR, you can just rip it out and get a cool scar as memento! Think barbles!

CAMP LIFE

- Never leave garbage or oil outside for the animals to find when you are fishing.
- Keep garbage that needs to be flown out in the cabin bagged up, we will find it and take it back to town with us.
- Do not feed the squirrels as they grow in to bears when mature dump fish guts in the lake across the bay from the dock by the sandy point [do not put them on shore as it attracts seagulls, hyenas and lions and bears].
- It is against the law to consume liquor while boating.
- Leave us a note on the white board if you need anything delivered.
- We will leave you a note with your pick up time, but if you have not heard from us then be ready by 6:30.
- Gather forest wood blow down for your outside fires, do not use the cut up wood, it is meant for the indoor stove.
- Make sure that you have life jackets in the boat with you.
- Burning garbage is a good idea but burn it clean and not food scraps.
- Finally, be sure to leave the cabin as clean as you expect to find it, swept clean, firewood box refilled, dishes done, coffee pot empty, garbage out of boat.
- If a group is not right behind you, pull up the boats on racks and pull the plug please.

ANGLING REGULATIONS

Miniss Lake is managed by Slate Falls Outposts as a high quality limited kill fishery. We only consume or keep walleyes under 18 inches northern maximum size is 27 inches.

Limit on a conservation license is 2 walleye and 2 northern [no oversized fish].

Lake Trout is a zero limit regardless of license.

Any frozen fish taken home must be flat with skin on it and one fish per bag.
Unfrozen fish just needs to have skin on it.

NOTEWORTHY NOTE: your possession limit includes all fish under your care and control, i.e. cleaned for dinner, ready for a trip to the States or in the frying pan or tied to the dock, two fish means two fish!
