

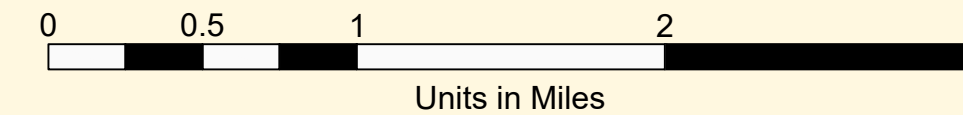
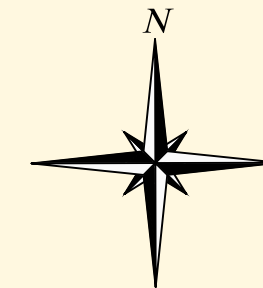

South Vincent, Winnow and Yam Lakes)

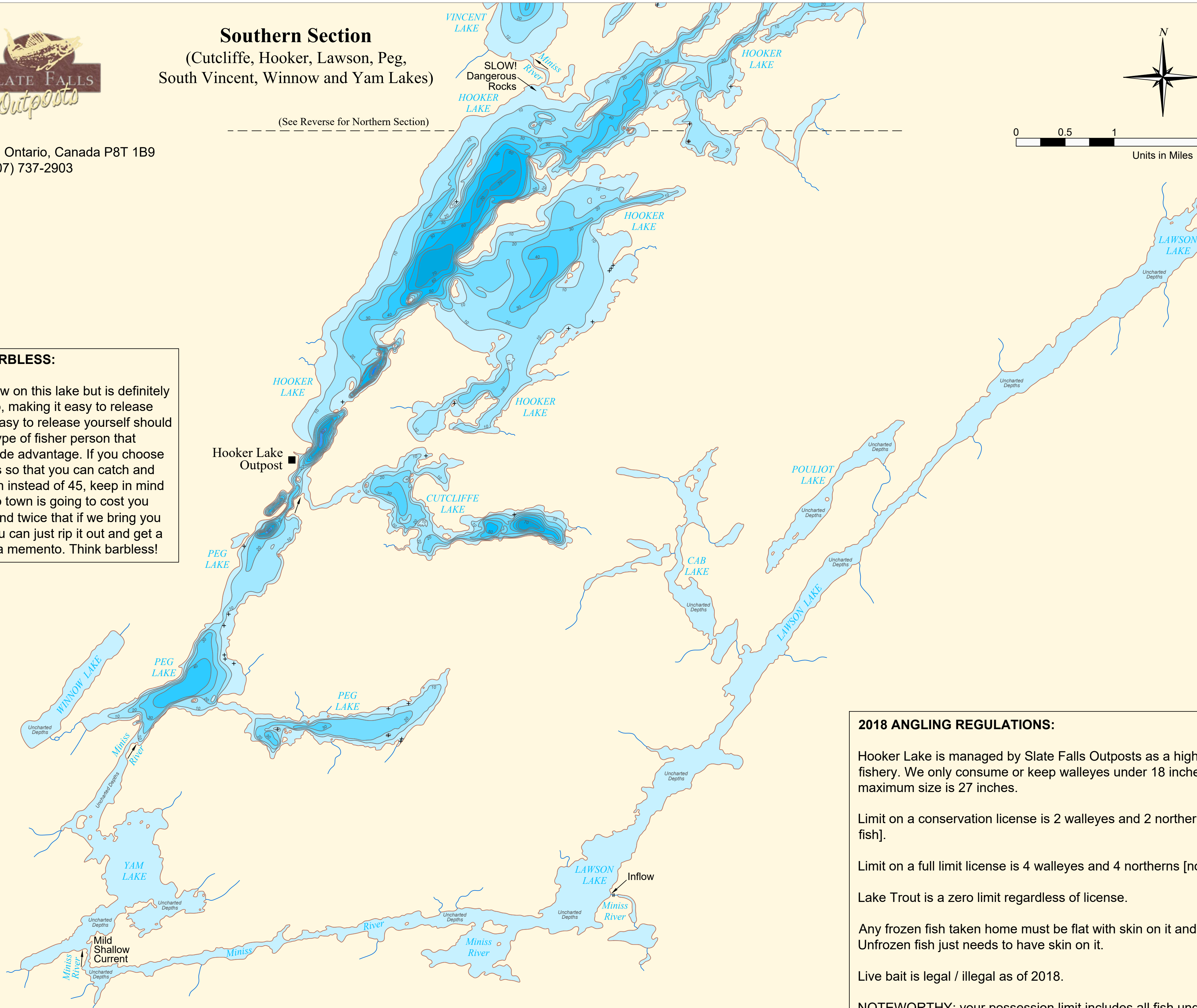
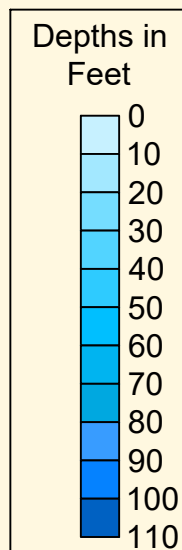

FISHING BARBLESS:

It is not the law on this lake but is definitely the way to go, making it easy to release your fish or easy to release yourself should you be that type of fisher person that needs an inside advantage. If you choose barbed hooks so that you can catch and handle 50 fish instead of 45, keep in mind that a flight to town is going to cost you about \$500 and twice that if we bring you back. OR, you can just rip it out and get a cool scar as a memento. Think barbless!



2018 ANGLING REGULATIONS:

Hooker Lake is managed by Slate Falls Outposts as a high quality limited kill fishery. We only consume or keep walleyes under 18 inches, northern maximum size is 27 inches.

Limit on a conservation license is 2 walleyes and 2 northerns [no oversized fish].

Limit on a full limit license is 4 walleyes and 4 northerns [no oversized fish].

Lake Trout is a zero limit regardless of license.

Any frozen fish taken home must be flat with skin on it and one fish per bag. Unfrozen fish just needs to have skin on it.

Live bait is legal / illegal as of 2018.

NOTEWORTHY: your possession limit includes all fish under your care and control, i.e., cleaned for dinner, ready for a trip to the States, tied to the dock or in the frying pan. Two fish means two fish!
