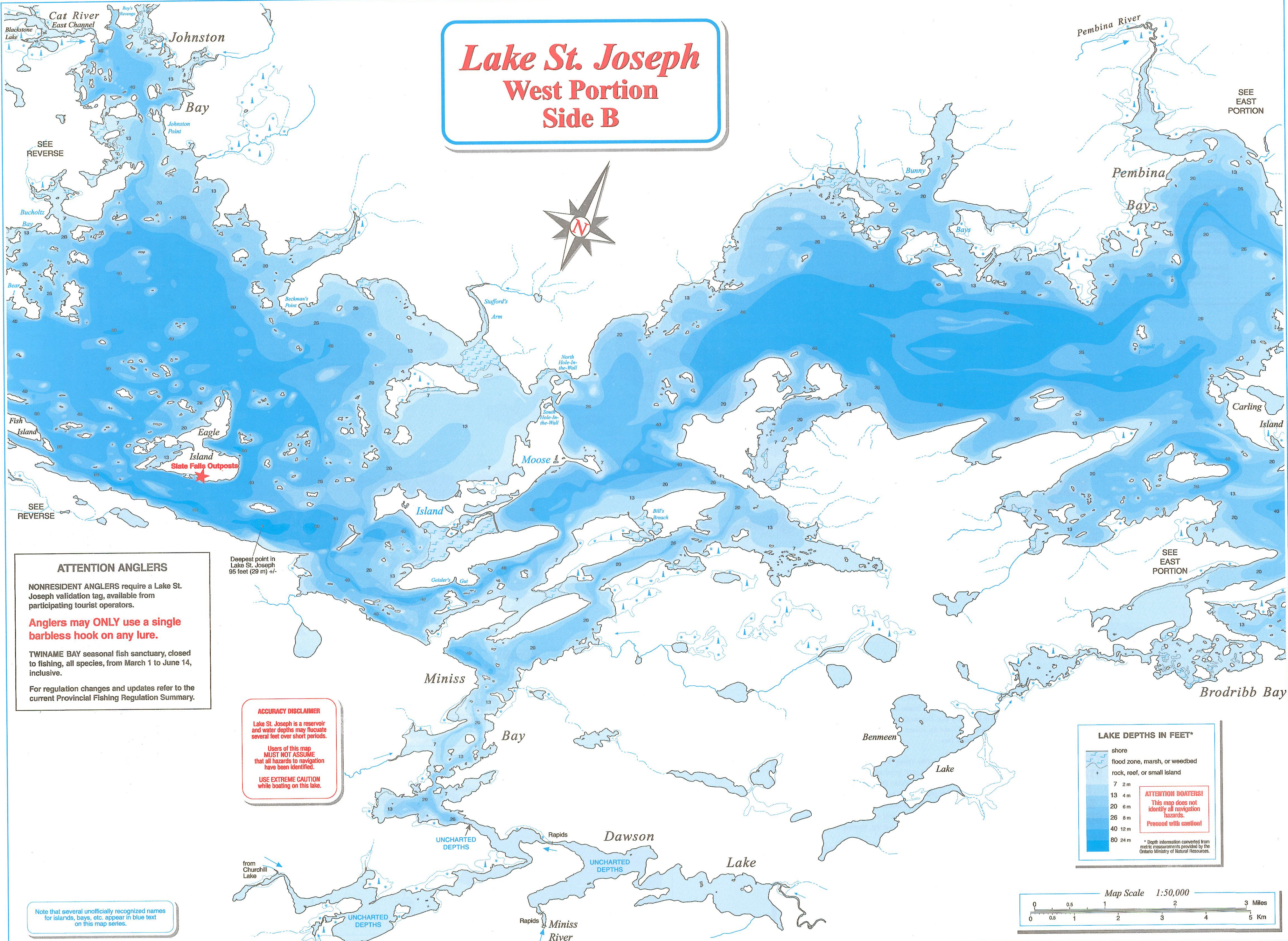


Lake St. Joseph West Portion Side B

ATTENTION ANGLERS

NONRESIDENT ANGLERS require a Lake St. Joseph validation tag, available from participating tourist operators.

Anglers may ONLY use a single barbless hook on any lure.

TWINAME BAY seasonal fish sanctuary, closed to fishing, all species, from March 1 to June 14, inclusive.
